I am Jackie Hyde (Director at Stanmore Insurance). Myself and my sister Sue Barker would like to share our story in Memory of our late father. In the latter stages of his life, dad had been diagnosed with vascular dementia and we had to go through the difficult process of obtaining a deprivation of liberty order, as he'd lost capacity in terms of his decision making.

We were fortunate in that I had a contact at Stephenson's solicitors who were able to provide advice on what the process involved and what we needed to do. We want to make sure other people are able to access similar support and advice.
